- When did this happen?

### 5. Why?

- Why did this happen?

- How did this happen?

## Questions to develop Critical Thinking

### 1. Who?

- Who is affected?
- Who benefits?
- Who loses?
- Who instigated this?
- Whose perspective is missing?

### 2. What?

- What caused this?
- What changes now?
- What else is this like?
- What information is available/missing?

### 3. Where?

- Where can I get further information?
- Where does the issue go from here?
- Where are similarities?
- Where are differences?

### 4. When?

- When have I seen this before?
- When did information become available?
- When can I act?

### 5. Why?

- Why is this happening now?
- Why am I seeing this?
- Why is/isn't action being taken?
- Why is this helpful/harmful?

### 6. How?

- How does this benefit/harm?
- How does this work?
- How do I know this to be true?
- How can I see this from another perspective?
