A Framework for Facilitation Skills Possible Reflective Prompts

Facilitation Prompt	Agree	Disagree	Reflections
I am confident in developing a shared language of understanding.			
The meeting structure allows for shared understandings to grow over time.			
I am well informed about productive conversation sequences.			
I am confident in constructing a safe learning environment.			
I provide opportunities for reflection.			
The SLAR meeting provides a springboard for conversations about teaching and learning.			
Teachers feel confident in their ability to judge the work of students.			
The meeting processes and actions are based on a shared set of values or principles.			
I am attentive and responsive to participants' emotions.

I am attentive to the learning opportunities within moments of anxiety, conflict, and tension.			
I allow participants to experience the more difficult emotions that sometimes arise.			
I am aware of my own feelings as I respond to interactions.			
Teachers can make the links between assessment and learning.			
I help to determine the direction of the meeting and offer support throughout.			
I ask probing questions, where necessary.
