### Analysis

How does the author use imagery to show how a character is feeling?  
Why did the author use this language? Explain your reasoning.



### Creating

If you were one of the characters, how would you react to a key moment?  
Have the views in this text affected your opinion? Why? How?



### Remembering

When and where is the text set?  
Who are the main characters? What do the characters look like?  
How does the text begin/end?



### Applying

Can you think of a text with a similar theme?  
Have you had a similar experience to one in the text?  
Can you think of an author with a similar style?



### Evaluating

Which text is better? Why?  
Which text is more persuasive?  
Did it have an effective ending?  
Who would you recommend this text to?
