## **Droichead in Numbers**

- 709 Post-primary schools trained in the Droichead process
- 3,388 Fully trained Post-primary Professional Support Team (PST) Members
- 1,994 Droichead applications received by the Teaching Council from Post-primary NQTs to date in this academic year
- 624 Post-primary schools currently supporting NQTs through the Droichead process

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PST Members	<ul> <li>As a PST member, please ensure your details are up-to-date on the Teaching Council's "My Registration" portal so that NQTs can select you as their PST member.</li> <li>A minimum of two PST members must be available to support an NQT through the Droichead process. While on leave, PST members are not permitted to support NQTs through the Droichead process.</li> <li>In the event that a PST member leaves the school, becomes ill etc., a school may request a replacement PST member via this online form.</li> <li>If a school is not in a position to nominate a replacement member, and has one remaining PST member, possible options to ensure the Droichead process can be facilitated in your school are the External Model (details here) or Interschool Model.</li> <li>If your school has any queries regarding access to PST training, please contact your Professional Learning Leader (PLL) to discuss. Application is via https://www.teachingcouncil.ie</li> <li>Cluster Meetings are offered in line with the Cluster Meeting Calendar 2023.2024 This should be read in tandem with Cluster Meetings: Important Information and Attendance Protocols</li> <li>Cluster Meeting 1 takes place face-to-face in local education support centres. Cluster Meetings 2 and 3 are offered online via Zoom. Cluster Meeting 2 will be offered trí Ghaeilge the week commencing 26th February.</li> <li>NQTs who commenced their Droichead process in Term 1 but did not complete Cluster Meeting 1 in Term 1 must email NQTinduction@oide.ie for advice on next steps.</li> <li>A suite of Online Induction Workshops is available to NQTs via our online learning platform. Many NQTs engage with the workshops as part of their Droichead process (as an Additional Professional Learning Activity - Strand B).</li> <li>Once NQTs have fully completed their Droichead process, they can log in to My Registration on the Teaching Council's website and complete Form D. This explanatory video further outlines the process. Please note that all five pages of Form D must be submitted.</li> </ul>
