



Circular Economy

- A sustainable economic model designed to minimise waste and make the most of resources by reusing, repairing, recycling, and repurposing materials for as long as possible
- Unlike the traditional "linear economy," which follows a "take-make-dispose" model, the circular economy seeks to create closed-loop systems that reduce environmental impact and conserve resources

Key Features of the Circular Economy

- Products are designed to be more durable, repairable, and recyclable from the start
- Materials and components are reused or recycled into new products instead of being discarded
- Organic waste is composted or converted into resources like bioenergy rather than ending up in landfills
